

What you need to know for your first lesson...

So you've decided you want to take lessons, filled out your registration form, paid your deposit, found a spot on the schedule... now it's time for your first lesson! I am so excited to have you as a part of Katy's Music Studio. Here are some things to know:

What you'll need:

- a **notebook** that we can use for every lesson any size will do, but the composition notebooks are sturdy, a good size, and ideal to use for lessons
- any **music** you already have if you've studied with another teacher or on your own
 - If you are studying piano or flute and are a beginner, new books have been purchased for the student and will be given on the first or second lesson and added to your tuition invoice.
 - For voice, a great deal of the music we use will be emailed and need to be printed.
 A binder or large folder will be a good way to bring this music to your lesson and keep it organized.
 - o If you are a flute or ukulele student, please always bring your instrument.
- A tote bag to keep everything together
- For **voice students**, a device that you can use to record a smart phone, laptop, iPod, iPad or handheld digital recorder. This needs to be brought to every lesson.

Please remember...

- Park in the gravel area, just past the driveway to the right. Please do not park in the driveway.
- The studio door is at the end of the driveway where the garage door would typically be.
- Restrooms are NOT available for use. Please plan accordingly.
- You may enter the studio without knocking. Please come into the studio no more than FIVE minutes before your lesson is scheduled to start. Katy may be finishing with another student. Your quiet patience is appreciated:-)
